## **OCTOBER MEETING**

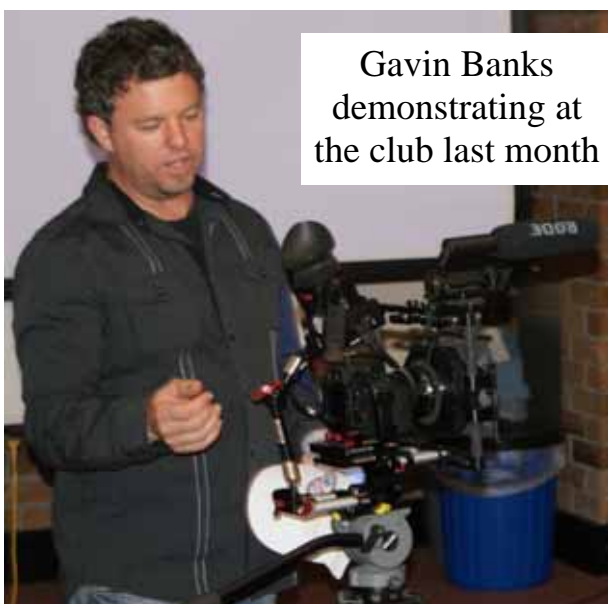

## Copying File Name/s & File Path/s ...

There are times when it's required to enter into the **Clipboard File Name/s** or **File Path/s** for use in a document like this article which was possible, but not easy. A **Freeware Shell Extension** program is available which does both plus a more and it is.

## ClipName for 32 & 64 Bit Windows ...

### Download Site:

<http://www.mainsoft.fr/en/downloads.htm>

Scroll down and download the **32-Bit (32K)** or **64 Bit (47K)** version or both. As the files are very small even those on **Dial Up** should have no trouble downloading. Extract each to its own Folder.

**ClipNameEn.zip** for **32-Bit Operating Systems**.  
(For **32-Bit Windows 95** to **Windows 7**)

**Clipname64En.zip** for **64-Bit Operating Systems**.  
(For **64-Bit Windows Vista** and **Windows 7**)

Folder contents below were done with **ClipName**.

### Installation:

**Right Click** on "**ClipName.inf**" file and **Click** on "**Install**" for **32-Bit Operating Systems**.

**Right Click** on "**ClipName64.inf**" file and **Click** on "**Install**" for **64-Bit Operating Systems**.

## Copy names (CRLF) option example.

## Copy names (Space) option example.

ClipName64.inf ClipName64.txt ClipName64.dll

**(CRLF) Carriage Line Feed.** Puts every entry on a new line like pressing **Return** to go to a new line.

**(Space)** does what it says. It puts a **Space** between every entry, but on the same line.

Please be aware that **ClipName** can copy into the **Clipboard** a combination of single or multiple **File Name/s** and **File Path/s** in one go.

## Windows Explorer Options ...

- Copy names (Space)
- Copy names (CRLF)
- Copy pathnames (Space)
- Copy pathnames (CRLF)
- Copy DOS pathnames (SPACE)
- Copy DOS pathnames (CRLF)
- Copy URL encoded names (Spaces)
- Copy URL encoded names (CRLF)
- Copy UNC encoded names (Space)
- Copy UNC encoded names (CRLF)

**Copy names** and **Copy paths** will be the most useful for the average user. Please read the enclosed Text file for more information on **ClipName**.

**Windows 7** has a **Right-Click Copy Path** option and unfortunately it attaches **Opening and Closing Quotes** which I find annoying.



## WinKey Keyboard Shortcut Keys ...

- WinKey+Ctrl+F** - Find: Computer.
- WinKey+D** - Show/Hide Desktop.
- WinKey+E** - Open an Explorer Window.
- WinKey+F** - Find: All Files.
- WinKey+F1** - Open Windows Help.
- WinKey+L** - Lock your computer or switch users.
- WinKey+M** - Minimize all open windows.
- WinKey+Pause** - Open the System Properties.
- WinKey+R** - Open the Run dialog.
- WinKey+Shift+M** - Undo minimize all open windows.
- WinKey+Tab** - Cycle through taskbar program buttons.

**WinKey+D** toggles between **Open Applications/ Explorer Windows** and the **Desktop** while the **WinKey+E** opens one or more instances of **Windows Explorer** and it's very useful in **Windows 7** and much easier than using **My Computer**. **JPL**
