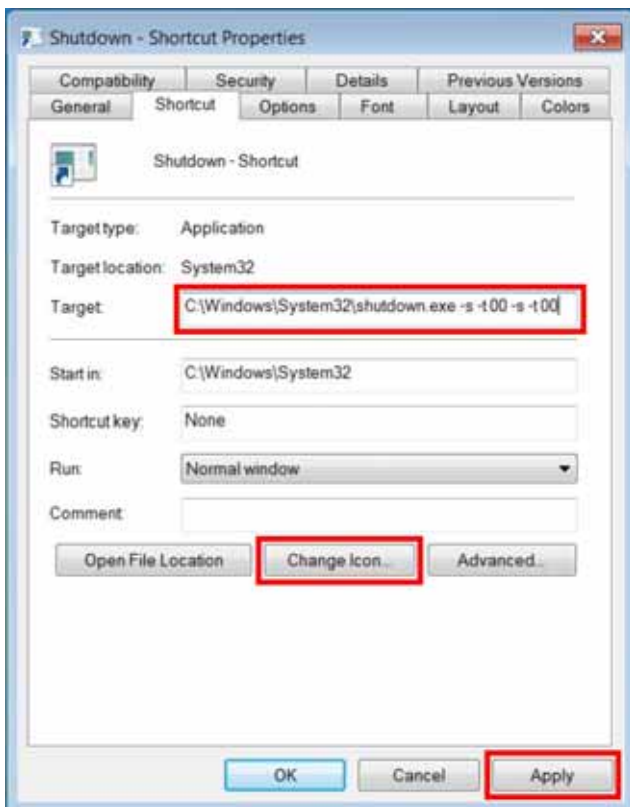
### Easy Windows 7 Restart & Shutdown ...

It's one of the first options I add to a new Install of **Windows**. The procedure is the same for both **Windows 7** and **Windows XP**. Open the **Windows** folder and then the **System32** folder. Find **Shutdown.exe** and place two Shortcuts on the **Desktop**. **Rename** first one to: **Shutdown PC** and the second to **Restart PC**.

**Right Click** on the **Shutdown PC** Shortcut and select **Properties**. In the **Target** Window add the highlighted bold text shown below. Please note, there is a space between each set of characters. **Repeat** for the **Restart PC** Shortcut and use **-r** instead for **Restart**.

**-s** = **Shutdown** **-T** = Time - **00** = Number of Seconds.  
**-r** = **Restart** **-T** = Time - **00** = Number of Seconds.

C:\Windows\System32\shutdown.exe **-s -t 00**  
 C:\Windows\System32\shutdown.exe **-r -t 00**



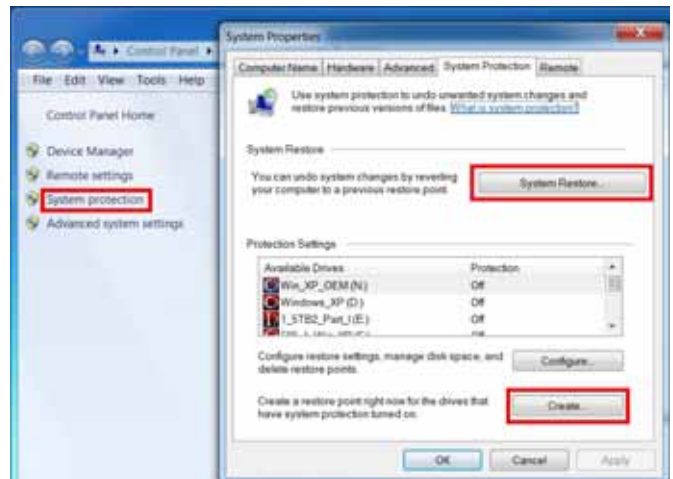
Next Click on **Change Icon** button, select Icon to suit as shown in the example below. Click **Apply** to finish. You can **Pin** them to the **Taskbar** or leave on **Desktop**. It's much easier to just simply Click once or twice on a single icon to **Restart** or **Shutdown** the **PC**.



### Easy Access to System Create/Restore Point ...

#### The Easy Way ...

Press & Hold the **Windows Key** and then the **Pause Key** and let go. Click on the **System protection** button to bring up **System Properties** which will allow you to **Create a System Restore Point** or **Restore** your System to an earlier made **System Restore Point**.

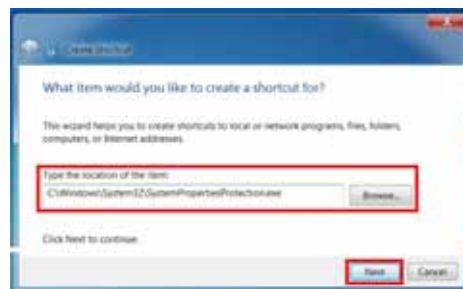


#### Create a Shortcut to System Properties ...

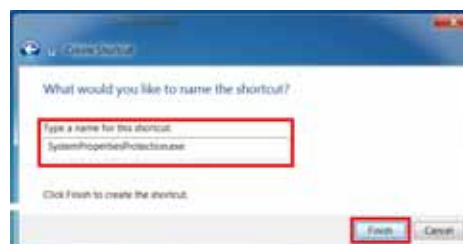
A Shortcut to **System Properties** is easy to create. **Right Click** on an empty space on the **Desktop** and select **Shortcut**. Next Type in location and **Click Next**:

C:\Windows\System32\SystemPropertiesProtection.exe

Change the default Name **SystemPropertiesProtection.exe** to **System Properties Protection** (any name can be used) and **Click Finish** and It's done.



The benefit of having a Shortcut is it can be **Copied** and **Saved** for use in any **Windows 7 PC**.



It's advisable to **Create System Restore Point** before Installing any new **Hardware** or **Software** as precaution. **JPL**
